Assessment Program

Purpose: Giltner Public School utilizes several assessment tools to identify the needs of Giltner Elementary students.

Assessment Tools and Purpose:

Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS) –Evaluates a student’s ability to read fluently.

Group Reading and Diagnostic Evaluation (GRADE)-Evaluates a student’s reading vocabulary and Comprehension.

Nebraska State Accountability Tests (NeSa)-Evaluates reading, math and science skills, required by the state of Nebraska.

Terra Nova Achievement Tests-Evaluates reading, math, science and English as compared to a national norm group.

Tools Used By Grade Level:

Kindergarten-DIBELS given in the Fall, Winter and Spring, progress monitoring on a monthly basis. GRADE test given in the spring only.

1st Grade-DIBELS given in the Fall, Winter and Spring, progress monitoring for students that fall below grade level scores. GRADE test given in the spring only.

2nd Grade-DIBELS given in the Fall, Winter and Spring, progress monitoring for students that fall below grade level scores. GRADE test given in the Fall and Spring.

3rd -4th Grade- DIBELS given in the Fall, Winter and Spring, progress monitoring for students that fall below grade level scores. GRADE test given in the Fall and Winter. NeSa tests given in the spring in reading and math.

5th Grade-DIBELS given in the Fall, Winter and Spring, progress monitoring for students that fall below grade level scores. GRADE test given in the Fall and Winter. NeSa tests given in the spring in reading, math and science.

6th Grade-DIBELS given in the Fall, Winter and Spring, progress monitoring for students that fall below grade level scores. GRADE test given in the fall and Winter. NeSa tests given in the spring in reading and math. Terra Nova norm referenced achievement tests given in the spring.

DIBELS and GRADE data reports will be shared with you during first semester parent/teacher conferences. NeSa reports from last spring will be mailed to you when they become available for public release in September. Winter and Spring scores will be mailed to your home.

The following are the minutes of the regular August Board meeting held August 15, 2011, in the Superintendent's Office conference room in Giltner, Nebraska at 7:00 p.m. as was advertised.

Item 1. Call meeting to order: President Hinrichs called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., with board members, Burson, Cates, Most, Hinrichs, Waddle, and Watson present. Burson moved that it hereby be determined that this public meeting was preceded by public notice and is determined to be legal and in open session. Open meetings laws are posted on the South Wall of the meeting room. Motion seconded by Most. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

Item 2. Review and act on Minutes of the regular July Meeting. Waddle moved to approve and accept the minutes of the regular July school board meeting as presented. Motion seconded by Cates. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

Item 3. Review Treasurer's reports for all funds: Treasurer and financial reports were read, discussed and accepted for all funds.

Item 4. Review Claims: Most moved to approve and pay July claims for the General Fund as presented. Motion seconded by Watson. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

Item 5. Requests to address the Board of Education: Yanda's Music of Kearney and Midwest Sound and Light of Lincoln presented proposals for sound in the gym and football field.

Item 6. Information Items: Principal Polt reported that the summer work projects are complete, that enrollment remains about the same as last year, participants in football is 23 and volleyball-21, discussed open house on Friday from 6:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and upcoming events for elementary students and JH/HS Band at State Fair in Grand Island.

Superintendent Lambert reported on Giltner's Little Einsteins Day Care and Pre-School and budget information.

Item 7. New Business:

A. Most motioned and seconded by Waddle to approve the Stephanie Hurst as a local substitute teacher for Giltner Public School. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

B. Burson motioned and seconded by Cates to approve first reading of SPED Policy 6010. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no

C. Watson motioned and Mostseconded to approve first reading of Discrimination Policy 4001. Motion carried by roll call vote : 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

D. Burson motioned and seconded byWaddle to approve the continuation of Giltner Public School in the NASB Medicaid Consortium for the 2011-2012 school year. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

E. Most motioned and seconded by Watson to approve Yanda's Music to install the sound system in the gym. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.
