## REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

### District #41-0002, (2R) in Hamilton County, Nebraska

#### Giltner Public School

The following are the minutes of the regular May Board meeting held May 14, 2012, in the Superintendent's Office conference room in Giltner, Nebraska at 7:00 p.m. as was advertised.

**Item 1. Call meeting to order:** President Hinrichs called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with board members Burson, Cates, Most, Hinrichs, Waddle, and Watson present. Cates moved that it hereby be determined that this public meeting was preceded by public notice and is determined to be legal and in open session. Open meetings laws are posted on the south wall of the meeting room. Motion seconded by Most. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

**Item 2. Review and act on Minutes of the regular April Meeting.** Waddle moved to approve and accept the minutes of the regular April school board meeting. Motion seconded by Burson. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

**Item 3. Review Treasurer's reports for all funds:** Treasurer and financial reports were read, discussed and accepted for all funds.

**Item 4. Review Claims:** Most moved to approve and pay May claims for the General Fund as presented. Motion seconded by Watson. Motion carried by roll call vote: 6 voted yes and 0 voted no.

**Item 5. Requests to address the Board of Education:**

Sarah Hoffman addressed the board about new band uniforms.

Watson left the meeting at 7:30 p.m.

**Item 6. Information Items:** Principal Polt reported on building and grounds projects, upcoming state track, semester test and moving 2013 graduation time to start at 2 p.m. Superintendent Lambert talked about breakfast program, band uniforms, student data, and board members who need to register for re-election, as well as the hiring of a new para-position for the 2012-13 school year.

**Item 7. New Business:**

- A. Cates motioned and second by Burson to set the half time superintendent salary for 2012-13 school at \$46,500 plus benefits. Motion carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.
- B. Most motioned and second by Burson to approve the hiring of Sarah Polt as the Giltner head cook for the 2012-13 school year. Motion carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.
- C. Burson motioned and second by Waddle to approve the hiring of Tracy Rhoades as the Giltner assistant cook for the 2012-13 school year. Motion carried by roll call vote : 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.
- D. Hinrichs motioned and second by Most to approve the football field lights with Hosier Electric Inc for 4 pole system with conduit added for \$42,290. (Hamilton Foundation approved \$31,000 and rest will come from Depreciation Fund) Motion carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.
- E. Waddle motioned and second by Most to approve a two year negotiation contract with Giltner Education Association for \$30,800 base for 2012-13 school year and \$31,500 base for the 2013-14 school year. (If health insurance goes up more than 5% then renegotiation will occur for the 2013-14 school year). Motion carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.
- F. Burson motioned and second by Cates to approve the Student School Fee as presented for the 2012-13 school year. Motion carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.
- G. Cates motioned and second by Hinrichs to approve the four school house leases to the current tenants for one more year. Motion carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.
- H. Waddle motioned and second by Most to approve the extra duty assignments as presented for 2012-13 school year. (Same as 2011-12 except new guidance counselor replaced previous guidance counselor duties). Motioned carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no.

**Item 9. Closed Session:** No

**Item 10. Set Time and Date of Next Regular Meeting:** The next regular board meeting is set for June 11, 2012, at 7:00 p.m.

**Item 11. Adjourn meeting:** Burson moved to adjourn the regular May meeting of the Board of Education. Motion seconded by Hinrichs. Motion carried by roll call vote: 5 voted yes and 0 voted no. The time was 7:58 p.m.
